### LHR SMOOTH JAMIE MAY & PHIL HANSON **DELIVER TOP COMPOSITE IN OPEN DERBY PRELIMS**



The ole saying "It ain't over til the fat lady sings" certainly fit the bill last night during the second go-round of the Open Derby, as 144 horses that had advanced to the second tier of competition battled it out for a slot in the Open finals.

In the case of this year's Breeder's Invitational Open Derby, the show wasn't over until "Jamie May" cut...LHR Smooth Jamie May that is, a mare who was guided by Phil Hanson to a 222 performance as the 134<sup>th</sup> work of the day that stole the high score of the round and nabbed the composite lead of this year's headline event.

With a 218 in the first go, the pair's superstar performance wasn't a necessity to secure their spot in the finals but, as Hanson explained, it's not hard



for that mare to rack up points.

"When everything goes right, she's easy to mark," he said proudly.

Hanson purchased LHR Smooth Jamie May (Smooth As A Cat x Just Scarlet x Smart Lil Ricochet) last year from Scott Johnson at Slate River Ranch not long after the 2009 Breeder's Invitational. He had seen her several times and was in the market for a NCHA Futurity mount when he sealed the deal for current-owner Sherry Chamberlin. According to Hanson, it didn't take much to get her geared up and ready for Fort Worth. "Scott did a really good job with her," he said. "She had a very, very strong and good foundation on her and it was easy from there on."

are often hard to get bought when cutters are scrambling for their most promising futurity prospects, Hanson said he was lucky to find her. "I was looking for the best 3-year-old I could find," he said. "I'd looked at a lot of them and she was the best one available."

On top of having all the right moves to impress the judges, Hanson said she is also blessed with a great disposition. "She's not hard to get along with or hard to school," he pointed out. "She just wants to please. Every time I'd go [to Johnson's], his daughter would be riding her (Cont. on Page 6)

## SMART STYLISH DATE \*\*\* MATT BUDGE WIN ROUND & COMPOSITE LEAD \$10K NOVICE DAINTY DUAL REY/ RICE \*\*\* SHADY LIL KITTY/ALLEN ALSO TIE FOR 2ND ROUND WIN



Matt Budge and Smart Stylish Date marked a 218 in the second round of the Derby Open that made them the \$10K Novice composite leader and tied them with both Ronnie Rice and Dainty Dual Rey as well as Clint Allen and Shady Lil Kitty for the goround's top score.

The Budge team earned a 216 in the first round that afforded the pair a 434 composite that boosted them to the top of that leader board.

**Rice and Dainty Dual Rey posted** 

a 213 in the first go-round, which earned them a 431 composite when added to the 218. And Allen's 212 on Shady Lil Kitty in the first round bought the pair a 430 composite and a slot in the \$10K Novice Open Derby Finals. At the end of the evening, it unofficially required a 428 cumulative score to advance to the division finals, which will be held today.

Joel Carson III, a lawyer from Roswell, N.M., owns Smart Stylish Date, who was bred by Thomas Turnbull, Hotchkiss, Co. Dee Merritt started the horse, who was sent to Budge in August of her 3-year-old year.

She had competed little because she had



been sidelined because of sore front feet after the Abilene Spectacular.

"I haven't gotten to show her hardly at all," Budge said. "I showed her at Abilene, where she did well in the first go-round and had heck in the second. Then her front feet got sore and we couldn't figure out what was wrong with her.

"I just now started back showing her. She's won maybe \$1,000 or \$1,500 at the most. She's been a real kind, sweet mare all along. She has a huge stop." "I felt like the run today went really well," he said. "We knew the cows well and cut the ones we wanted. I was just tickled the way the whole thing came together."

# HIGH BROW KWACKIN & TJ GOOD DELIVER TOP 2ND ROUND AND COMPOSITE SCORES IN LIMITED OPEN DERBY

TJ Good's success at this year's BI continued as he and High Brow Cat Kwackin led the Derby Limited Open composite and the second round of the class yesterday, as well.

Good and the High Brow Cat gelding out of Kwackin by Dual Pep marked a 217.5 that was a half-point higher than their first-go score, which was the top mark of the first round. The former roper and cow horse trainer also rode another horse, Docs Hickory Kitty, to tie for the high score of 217 in the first round of the Limited Open Derby. Good and High Brow Kwackin's 434.5 composite



puts them in the leadership position as they head to the Derby Open and Limited Open finals May 29. Good already had won this year's BI Open Classic/Challenge with Jackson Land & Cattle's mare, Bet On Merada. The Wyoming, company, who also has a ranch in Weatherford, Texas, also owns High Brow Cat Kwackin. Bred by Jack and Linda Kenney, Millsap, Texas, the easy-going gelding was easy to train, Good said. "He was always just an easy, laid-back colt, almost lazy," he explained. "He took training good and just matured as it went, and turned into a good horse."



The New Mexico native has earned more than \$156,000 in reined cow horse events, but is currently focusing more on cutting. "That's the direction Jackson Land and Cattle want to go and more the direction I want to go now, too." he said.

# TULSA .... THE HISTORY BEHIND THE CITY



The earliest settlers of the Tulsa area date back to the Ozark Bluff Dwellers. They lived in the northeast part of Oklahoma, otherwise know as Green Country. The Native American population came to the area in 1836 by way of the infamous Trail of Tears. Their journey ended beneath the branches of the Council Oak Tree, located on the east side of the Arkansas River. It was here that many decided to make their home. They called their settlement Tallahassee. Today this spot is 18th and Cheyenne near downtown Tulsa.

The "Five Civilized Tribes," Cherokees, Choctaws, Chickasaws, Creeks and Seminoles, also came to the area. They brought with them their ideas of trading and commerce, ideas that would influence and shape the Tulsa area as well as the state of Oklahoma. For the next decades, the

area remained untamed wilderness with only a few settlers and mostly Native Americans. The war forced many residents to flee the area. Fortunately, the reconstruction period after the war contributed to the growth of the area. In 1879 the first Post Office opened, followed by the arrival of the railroad. By this time the area became known as Tulsey Town as it grew to be a trading post and cattle town.

It wasn't until the establishment of the Post Office in March 1879 that the name Tulsa was adopted as the growing city's name. In 1882, Tulsa's population was about 200. But, by the time the city was incorporated on January 18, 1898, the population had sprouted to 1,100. Another growth jump was attributed to an oil well called Sue Bland No.1 that struck oil at Red Fork, across the river from Tulsa. This giant reserve of oil and natural gas would come to be known as the Glenn Pool Strike.

Not all was prosperous in the early days of Tulsa. During the 1920s, it had become evident that the Arkansas River was no longer a suitable water supply. Citizens of Tulsa supported a multimillion dollar bond to bring water from the Spavinaw Hills. This was considered to be one of the largest public works projects in the country during this era.

It was not until after World War II that an increase in offshore drilling operations affected the petroleum industry. Fortunately, the aircraft and aerospace industry was beginning to blossom. American Airlines built a major maintenance center and SABRE reservation system relocated from New York to Tulsa. To date, there are more than 300 aviated-related companies in Tulsa. Another means of transportation did not come to Tulsa until 1970, when the Tulsa Port of Catoosa opened. This linked Tulsa with the rest of the world via river navigation to the Mississippi River and the Gulf of Mexico. Such advancements have made Tulsa a diverse city full of opportunity. Not only national corporations, but international corporations have made Tulsa their home. For instance, American Airlines, Kimberly-Clark, Ford Glass, State Farm, Thrifty, Dollar, Hilti, Avis, MAPCO, Citgo, and Whirpool are just a few of the leading businesses whose corporate offices reside in Tulsa today.

around bareback. She's just that type of a horse and they loved her."

After more than \$70,000 in winnings later, Hanson loves her, too. Although the pair didn't make it past the second go at the Futurity, they've certainly hit a lick this year. The mare's first trip out was the Bonanza Cutting and she and Hanson took home top honors and \$30,000.

From there, the pair finished 3<sup>rd</sup> at the Arbuckle Futurity and recently made the Open finals at the NCHA Super Stakes, as well. "She just keeps getting a little bit better all the time," Hanson said of the horse's success this year.

While many may view Hanson as a "west coast cutter" he has permanently moved his operation from Oregon to Weatherford, Texas, and is running it out of Chamberlin's Lazy H Ranch. Weatherford, which attracts more and more cutters every year, is not only more convenient for the Fort Worth events, but is also a much more pleasing climate, Hanson said. "Basically, you're locked inside dealing with below freezing temperatures for at least four months straight (in Oregon). Most of the time,

you're inside for five or six months. It's a lot easier to conduct business when you're not having to deal with freezing pipes every day," he added. These days the Hanson family is calling Texas home and they are glad to do so.

Up until Hanson's 222-point run on Wednesday, Clint Allen and Stilish Rey had held the lead of the second go with a 220. Things didn't go exactly as planned for the pair during the first go of the Open Derby on Monday when they marked a 213 to barely make it to the second go. Once they got there, however, Allen knew what he had to do in order to secure a shot in the Open finals.

No stranger to marking high scores, the NCHA Hall of Fame Rider, put the stallion's abilities to the test and eased into the finals with only a half point to spare.

Stilish Rey (Dual Rey x Moms Stylish Pepto x Peptoboonsmal) showed great promise early on as a 2-year-old. When the NCHA Futurity rolled around last year, he made the cut as one of Allen's Open contenders. During their debut they finished in the top 10 of the Open finals for a hefty first time check of \$70,000 for the horse.
